

End of Season Notes

ALL MONEY IS DUE TONIGHT! THERE IS A NOTE IN YOUR ENVELOPES STATING HOW MUCH YOU OWE. THE ATM IS FULL AND UP AND RUNNING.

STRIKE POT:

It appears no one is going to hit the strike jackpot. Frankly, only 1 or 2 times has it even been close. It is time for me to make a decision on what we are going to do when it doesn't get hit by next week. It looks like the number is going to wind up between \$7,000-\$7,500.

Next week, (5/15/25) we are going to draw to draw 5 numbers, all at once. The first number drawn will go first, second number goes second, and so on. The first ticket will go in Frame 1, Game 3. The second ticket, Frame 3. Third, Frame 5. Fourth, Frame 7. Fifth, Frame 9. If none of the five teams hit the jackpot, we will then move to a raffle. \$2,500 will be raffled off to the sixth ticket pulled. The remaining money (approx. \$4,500) will be carried over to next season. An additional \$2,500 will be donated next season, making the Week 1 Strike Pot total next year approximately \$7,000.

END OF SEASON PAYOUTS:

Payouts will be available for pickup starting on Monday, May 26th, 2025, at 12:00pm. League money can be picked up at the front desk. This will go for any money won in the league, including the roll-off and strike jackpot. Unfortunately, I am traveling the next two weeks and will not be here either the 15th or 22nd, therefore we are doing the payout the following week. A full final prize fund breakdown will be posted on our website by 9:00am on Monday, May 19th, and it will be handed out to each team picking up money. When you pick up money, you will be picking it up for the entire team and signing for your team's money. Please coordinate accordingly.

RETURNING SHEETS AND NEXT SEASON PREVIEW:

Next week, return sheets will be passed out to each team to determine who is coming back to the league next season. The league will be staying at 5-man teams and 34 weeks; however, the league dues will be increasing to \$35 per week. That \$5 increase is going to add \$25,000 to our prize fund. Next year, we will feature an expanded roll-off with 7 teams. A format change will also be in effect, with (4) 8-week quarters and a 2-week Desperado quarter where 1 team will make the roll-off with the highest win total for those two weeks. Two wild-card teams based on season win totals will also make the roll-off. Next year's prize fund will be over \$125,000.
