ENTRY:

There is no separate entry fee beyond the standard weekly league lineage.

The youth bowler must be ***up to date each week in league fees to be eligible.***

All "Majors" and "Minors" bowlers meeting eligibility requirements are automatically entered. *(Minimum of 21 games average needed.)*

** Eligibility to be verified by the Mid-County Youth League Accounting personnel.*

**** For scores to be eligible they must be bowled on the scheduled league day as part of standard scheduled league match play bowling.**

**** Pre-bowl and Post-bowl scores are not eligible.***

** Score eligibility to be verified by the Mid-County Youth League Secretarial personnel.*

\$500 Scholarship Funds will be awarded as follows:

(based on 39 in Majors and 13 in Minors ratio as of Dec 31)

Majors Division:

1st Place --- \$180
2nd Place --- \$120
3rd Place --- \$ 60

Minors Division:

1st Place --- \$ 95
2nd Place --- \$ 45

***** All winners will need to provide the following information for proper processing of scholarship funds:**

Youth bowler's full name, date of birth, current age, home address, USBC Bowler Membership number, and Parent or Guardian phone contact number.

*** Failure to provide the needed information by the date requested by the tournament committee after results are tabulated will result in forfeiture of the scholarship funds, which will then be offered to the next eligible bowler by score rankings.

*** Scholarship Fund processing into the USBC SMART system will be handled by Ken Condiff (Alumni Fund Administrator), based on final results submitted.

*** A record of the scholarship deposits will be provided by Ken Condiff to the Tournament Committee once processing is completed, and this information will in turn be shared with the winning recipients.

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All USBC league and tournament rules / regulations will govern: Open only to NDUSBC Youth Members with sanctioned average participating in the Mid-County Youth league in Major and Minor Divisions.
2. Current weekly Mid-County Youth League average (**Minimum of 21 games**) and handicap will be used for each of the scheduled in-league scholarship tournament weeks.
3. Scholarships will be awarded in both Major and Minor Divisions separately, based on cumulative handicapped total of the first six games bowled across the scheduled weeks. Ratio of positions paid in scholarship is related to number for youth bowlers in each division.
4. Errors in average and/or handicap must be reported within 48 hours following each scheduled week of the tournament competition. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the tournament committee and the tournament director who will be the final authority unless an appeal is filed under USBC rule 329. The penalty for any infraction is disqualification from the tournament.
